

Dear Conference Participant,

1. The administrator of your personal data will be the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń with its registered office at Gagarina 11, 87-100 Toruń and Fundation Academy of Biology and Environmental Protection with registered office at Lwowska 1, 87-100 Toruń.
2. The purpose of processing your personal data is to organize a conference under the title „Plant productivity and food safety: Soil science, Microbiology, Agricultural Genetics and Food quality”
3. Your personal data will be processed on the basis of:
 - a. art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f) Regulation 2106/679 of the European Parliament and of the EU Council from 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / WE (GDPR), i.e. in legitimate interests, such as:
 - efficient organization of conferences,
 - the possibility of establishing contact with conference participants,
 - sending marketing information (only events organized by the University).
 - b. art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c) GDPR:
 - provisions of generally applicable law regarding accounting and taxes.
4. When you give us your consent, your data will also be processed for the purposes of publishing information about the conference along with disclosing your image. Remember that in the event of consent, you have the right to withdraw it at any time, but without affecting the processing that was carried out before its withdrawal.
5. Personal data, due to the purposes for which they are processed, will be stored until your objection is raised, but not shorter than required by the law on accounting and taxes.
6. You have the right to request access to your personal data, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing.
7. You also have the right to object to the processing.
8. Raising an objection to the processing of personal data, before the event, will prevent participation in the conference and, moreover, does not have any other consequences.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
10. Your personal data will not be transferred to other entities.
